SPELLING INVESTIGATION:

We are going to be learning about the suffixes -ed, -ing, -s and -es. Create an activity to help other children learn the rules for adding these to a root word.

Make a game to help your learn Roman Numerals up to 12.

Draw and label a plan of a playpark or area you enjoy visiting with your family.

Complete the reading comprehension:
Women's World Cup.

Design a game that involves magnets.
Write instructions on how to plan the game.

Make your own Roman mosaic. You could use cut up paper, seeds, pasta.
Make your design simple and clear.

Metacognition: What helps me to learn? Discussion with members of your family or friends. Do we all learn in the same way?

Draw and describe a Roman chariot. What were the chariots used for? Who used them?

Learn at least 5 facts about a Gladiator. Make a fact file about what their life was like.
